# OPTUS STADIUM & STADIUM PARK

Optus Stadium and its surrounding Stadium Park is a destination for all Western Australians and visitors alike to enjoy 365 days a year.

This ever-growing entertainment precinct reflects Perth's unique culture, makes the most of the nearby Derbarl Yerrigan (Swan River) and acknowledges the site's important Aboriginal history and significance. It's a must-visit destination in Perth.

The stadium and surrounding Stadium Park, is located east of the Perth CBD on the Burswood Peninsula. Easily accessible from the city, the 60,000 seat, world-class, multi-purpose Stadium hosts a variety of sports and entertainment events, including Australian Football League (AFL), International and Big Bash League cricket (BBL), soccer, rugby league and union, plus concerts.

Major events are just one part of the Optus Stadium story – with multiple adventure and educational tours operating seven days a week as well as playgrounds, restaurants, public art, picnic and barbecue facilities throughout making it a world-class entertainment and tourism destination.

Harnessed from above, you're free from constraint and can take this experience as far off the edge as your senses allow. Did we mention there's no handrails?

This 90-minute rooftop experience is for the fun, for the fearless, for the fans. Grab your mates and take on the challenge. VERTIGO, heighten your senses.

### **The Western Viewing Deck**

With access to the new Western Viewing Deck, our roof now gives you even better views of the Derbarl Yerrigan (Swan River), the Matagarup Bridge and unique views of Perth City. Take in the sights as you take in your breath, you're going to need it.

### **The Harness**

Hooked yet? The safety harness hooks from above, so you have freedom in movement. Dare to look down? All around? How far are you going to push your limits?

## An enjoyable walk on top of the World's Most Beautiful Stadium

Think you've seen every level of Optus Stadium? Think again! Our rooftop tour gives you behind-the-scenes access, a unique perspective of Perth and a bird's eye view from the top of the stadium. Safe and secure, the 360-degree walk will give you access to insider knowledge on game day operations and how the stadium was constructed on beautiful Whadjuk Noongar Country.

### Entry to the roof

From Level 5, you'll access the roof via a behind-the-scenes staircase to the famous sails of the Optus Stadium roof. It's as easy as walking up a flight of stairs. Need a lift? We have one of those too, so if you do have accessibility needs, please visit the FAQs for more information.

### Safe and secure

Once on the roof you'll be locked in with a strong footing on the rooftop pathway. Handrails on both sides of the 1.2-metre-wide track, you'll feel at ease as you circumnavigate the roof.

### 360-degree tour

Starting from the south side of the stadium, take in the views of the Burswood Peninsula, Herron Island and Crown Resort complex. Move to the East and watch the planes take off from Perth Airport and see the expanse of the Perth

hills. Head northside for more expansive views of Perth's inner suburbs before reaching the newest addition to the HALO rooftop tour, the Western Viewing Deck for spectacular views of the city.

### The Western Viewing Deck

With access to the new western viewing deck, our roof now gives you even better views of the Derbarl Yerrigan (Swan River) and unique views of Perth City. Unclip from your safety lanyard and walk the deck to view Stadium Park from above. Breathe it all in. Take a few minutes to absorb the view and pose for your unique city skyline photo.

### Our Tour Leaders

Our rooftop tour leaders guide you safely around the roof and inform you of the little-known facts about the stadium's construction and technology. They regale tales from game days gone by and highlight their favourite landmarks of Perth. Got questions? Inquisitiveness welcomed.

## Go behind the scenes at Optus Stadium

For those who prefer their feet planted firmly on the ground, a behind the scenes Optus Stadium tour is just the ticket.

This in-depth walking tour caters for all ages and abilities and takes fans inside Optus Stadium and through areas usually reserved for VIPs.

Guests tour the changerooms of the Fremantle Dockers, West Coast Eagles and the Perth Scorchers in this all-encompassing behind-the-scenes tour.

Visitors also view the field of play from some of the best vantage points in Optus Stadium – including sitting at ground level on the benches usually occupied by the stars of the game. You can also take a moment to imagine you're an AFL coach or part of the sports media when you take a walk through the state-of-the-art Dennis Cometti Media Centre.

The tour covers about 2.5km on foot with several stops along the way, walking at a steady pace. The tour is accessible for those in wheelchairs or using mobility aids.

## Optus Stadium stands on the land of the Whadjuk people of the Noongar Nation

The Stadium was carefully designed with input from a group of local Aboriginal people – the Whadjuk Working Party.

Warrang Bridil's Aboriginal Cultural Tours aim to 'close the gap' on knowledge and understanding of Nyoongar people's heritage through the sharing of their culture.

Join one of Warrang-Bridil's guides on a walking tour along the shores of the Derbal Yerrigan (Swan River).

As part of the tour, see and understand Nyoongar cultural influence in the development of the Optus Stadium Precinct and Matagarup Bridge. You will also have the opportunity to join in a traditional Nyoongar Ceremony and understand how cultural tools and artefacts are paving the way for modern technology.

Understand the importance of culture, language, values, relationships, responsibilities, a shared purpose, wisdom, knowledge and social structures in aboriginal culture.

Attendees hear stories of how the Nyoongar People lived in a functional community with value, purpose and leadership in nurtured environments.



## No matter the tour, there's always an option to complement the experience.

The stunning City View Café is open 7am to 3pm daily (with exceptions on event days).

The City View Café is located on the river side of Optus Stadium near Gate D and is accessible via the stairs or lift.

There's also the opportunity to take a stroll along the BHP Boardwalk winding through the Chevron Parkland or explore the public art on display in Stadium Park.

The BHP Amphitheatre provides sloped, grass seating for about 1,000 people all with a spectacular view of the Swan River and Perth CBD.

All these experiences are open to the public daily, making them a fun and easy way to make the most of a visit to Optus Stadium.
